



The CPGA is offering 3 wether, doe and buck NPGA Sanctioned Open Shows and 1 wether, doe Sanctioned Youth Show. Animals with original registration papers, delayed certification transfer of ownership (dated within 90 days of the show), or progeny verification forms will be allowed to show. No papers required for wethers. NPGA rules to govern and to take precedence over all others.

ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN: Goats must arrive between 6pm and 9pm on Wednesday (April 18) or between 7am and 11am on Thursday (April 19)

DEPARTURE: Designated release time is 6pm for out of state participants and no later than 8pm for WA participants (the last few years they have been letting most leave earlier than 8pm)

SHOW TIMES: Thursday Youth Show—4pm; Open shows begin at 10am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday

HEALTH CHECK: Do not bring animals with obvious signs of illness (runny nose, visible sores, lice, diarrhea, etc.). Health checks will be made by fair veterinarian. No refunds for failed vet checks. Scrapie ID is required. If you do not have a Scrapie ID, it is a simple phone call to USDA APHIS in Olympia, WA (360-753-9430).

ENTRY FEES: \$8.00 per animal, per day (CPGA Members) \$10 per animal per day (Non-CPGA members)

Youth Entry Fee is \$3.00 per goat. Showmanship entries are \$3.00 per exhibitor per day. Prospect Wether Entry Fee is \$3.00 per goat per day

NOTE: Overall Grand / Reserve Grand Showmanship (top 2 winners in each age group except PeeWee) will take place on Sunday. Special prizes will be awarded

JACKPOT WETHER: Nominate your wether if you think he may win Best Wether. \$5 per wether per day.

Entries postmarked after SATURDAY, April 7th will be charged \$3 late fee per entry. Only exchanging entered animals within same class will be accepted without a late fee. There will be no refunds given for any reason except severe hardship at the discretion of the CPGA show committee. Please return entries on the form provided—do not make your own. Copies of the forms are acceptable. **Sign and return with FULL PAYMENT**

PENS: Pens are approximately 5x5'. Remember to bring fir bows and good smelling stuff to display near buck pens per fair supervisor's request. Pen Fee is \$6 per each pen.

DIRECTIONS TO FAIRGROUNDS: From the SOUTH ~ I-5 to Hwy 512E (exit 127) towards Puyallup. Travel approximately 8 miles. Take the Meridian exit off of 512 (at bottom of hill). Turn right on Meridian and head back up hill to 15th Ave. Turn right and cross under Hwy 512. Turn right at the first street after the underpass. This will take you to the service gate of the fairgrounds.

From the NORTH ~ Take 1-405 south. Take the Auburn exit to Hwy 167 south. Travel approximately 20 miles on Hwy 167 to the Hwy 512 W exit. Continue on 512 and take the Meridian St exit. Turn left at light and head up hill to 15th Ave SE. Turn right and cross under Hwy 512. Turn right at 1st street after the underpass. This will take you to the service gate of the fairgrounds
